If you want to come along to learn or jam together with other attending visual artists, or if you want to help us, feel free to come around. If you want to talk about something or host a workshop, you are very welcome.

The lectures are bound to a maximum of one hour and are to be held in english or german. The workshops can be as long as two hours. The length of the showcases will depend on numerous factors. There are the "normal" showcases if you just want to show your current work to an interested audience. Please drop us a line of your intention and personal interests so we can measure demand better and adjust the offers and timings. Please tell us your contact information and send us a screenshot or showreel link of your work. In case you want to offer a lecture or workshop, please tell us the topic and give some overview about it.

The μ:avit programme will be published and updated on an almost daily basis until may 21st.
